



## Spanish Cross in Bronze Wilhelm DEUMER Lüdenscheid

### Description

The Spanish Cross (Spanienkreuz) was instituted on April, 14th 1935 by A. Hitler (14.4.1939, RGBl. IS.1939, 1360). The bronze class was awarded 7869 times during the main Legion Condor return parades in Hamburg and Döberitz. The famous Deumer company manufactured the Spanish Cross during the war. This one is showing the LDO mark L/11, stamped on the reverse. This post 1941 cross was made in bronze and is private purchase. The attachment system, hinge and pin, are typical for this maker. The hinge is an EK type. Note the 3 arms are cut out in each eagle's swastika.
